

### *Concept Map: Day in History (40 Pts)*

#### Steps

1. Look at the example on the next sheet of the assignment (You may not use this topic).
2. Open New Document in Word and save as: Day In History Two
3. Go to: <http://memory.loc.gov/ammem/today/today.html>
4. Read about the story/event/person and scroll down to the bottom of the page and look at the related material and the links
5. Decide if you are interested in it
6. If you are interested in what you see, GO TO > # 8.
7. If you are not interested in it, go to: “**Archive**” as shown below

9. Search for a topic that interests you.
10. Read about the topic you've chosen
11. You may also use the History Channel Day in History if you don't find a topic you like at the Library of Congress site
12. Open your concept map and copy it to a new document or create the new doc from the concept map using File > Save As
13. Write a title about the story or use the one from the web site
14. Read about the event again.
15. Write the Main Idea of the even in the center Main Idea box of the concept map
16. Find the facts. Copy four facts into the four outside Facts Boxes of the concept map
17. Paste the link of the site at the bottom of the document – you'll need this to get back to the site
18. Spell Check, and use Print Preview to review you work
19. Use this completed concept map to complete the “Day in History” assignment
20. You may print and refer to the hard copy while you are working on “Day in History”
21. Staple this concept map in front of the “Day in History” assignment and turn both in together
