SuccessMaker Enterprise Naming Convention Options

SuccessMaker allows for a great deal of flexibility in naming groups of students depending on the needs of the students, the needs of the classroom teacher or lab manager for instructional purposes, as well as interventions for students. The following are several examples of naming conventions that have been used in District 11 for SuccessMaker:

(grade level) (Teacher last name) (period-if secondary) (category)

07Brilliant03 = 7th grade, Brilliant's class, Period 3
00Brilliant = Kindergarten, Brilliant's class
08Brilliant04SPED = 8th grade, Brilliant's class, Period 4, SPED
02BrilliantILP = 2nd grade, Brilliant's class, ILP students

(school number or school name) (grade level) (Teacher last name) (period-if secondary) (category) (course)

101 04 Brilliant mcs
Adams 04 Brilliant ILP rw
242 06 Brilliant 06 mcs
Holmes 06 Brilliant 04 Tier 2 rw

For overall school level reporting and to allow aggregated reporting for the district, here's an example of how to name a group to allow reporting for either Reading or Math by only selecting a single group:

(school number or school name) (grade level) ALL

118 04 ALL
Audubon 05 ALL
