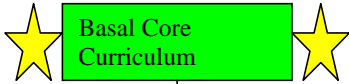

GATE Tier 3: Problem Solving Team

Tier 1 Classroom Interventions, including, but not limited to the following examples:

- Pikes Peak Literacy Strategies
- I've DIBEL'd Now What?(Book)
- Comprehensive Literacy Resources
- Math Wrap-ups
- Math games
- Team Interventions
- Success Maker
- Tier 1 Goal Group

Teacher to send Parent Letters

Minimum of two interventions with a minimum of 4 Aimsweb/DIBELS data points

Any student with an IEP that comes to the school from out of state or district will start with GATE

Need: Gate Referral Form and Parent Survey.

Completed by the RtI Team:

- Student interview
- Parent invited to meeting

Process:

- Detailed individual look at each student, including analysis of data
- Individualized Plan developed
- Tier 3 Interventions
- More Intense Academic interventions: Multi-sensory, Orton Gillingham, LindamoodBell, Cloud Nine, StarLit, Connecting Math Concepts, Early Reading Intervention, Triumphs, LIPS.

2 interventions with a minimum of 4 data points each prior to starting the SPED evaluation

Student is Resistive to Interventions and the process for Special Education eligibility is started

GATE Tier 1: Monday Data Review Resource Team:

Examples of services to be provided, include, but are not limited to:

- Suggesting individual student Tier 1 Interventions
- Data Collection Assistance (PDSA) needed for Tier 2 Referrals

GATE Tier 2: Tutor Data Referral Reviews (last Wednesday of Each Month)

- Reading Intervention group: Read Well, StarLit, Explode the Code, Versatiles, SM-Strands.
- Math Intervention group: Math by Topic, Knowing Mathematics, multi-sensory activities, Math Wraps, Versatiles, SM-Strands, Explode the Code

Office to send Parent Letters

Minimum of 2 interventions with 4 data points each
