

**SCHOOL DISTRICT PERSONNEL PERFORMANCE EVALUATION ADVISORY COUNCIL**

The Board of Education shall appoint, pursuant to state law, an advisory school district personnel performance evaluation council which shall, as a minimum, consist of one teacher, one administrator, one principal, one parent and one person who does not have a child in school.

The council may be composed of any other school district committee having membership as defined above.

The council shall consult with the board as to the fairness, effectiveness, credibility and professional quality of the certificated personnel performance evaluation system and its processes and procedures. The council shall monitor the implemented evaluation process and every two years shall conduct a compliance audit of the evaluation system.
