

## QUORUM

Except as otherwise may be required by law or Board of Education ("Board") policy, a majority of members of the Board shall constitute a quorum necessary for the transaction of any business.

If less than a majority of Board members are present at a Board of Education regular or special meeting, a majority of those who are present may adjourn the meeting until such time as a quorum is present without further notice other than an announcement at the meeting.

~~A Board of Education member who is participating in the regular or special meeting by conference call or speaker phone shall be counted the same as a member who is present.~~

*In order to vote or otherwise participate in any regular or special meeting (including executive sessions) or work session of the Board, Board members must be physically present at such meeting or session. In this regard, Board members are expressly prohibited from voting or otherwise participating in a regular or special meeting (including executive sessions) or work session by telephone or by other similar means. Board members who are not physically present at a regular or special meeting (including executive sessions) or work session of the Board are entitled to receive copies of any materials prepared for or in connection with the meeting or session.*
