

## **STATE LEGISLATIVE PROGRAM**

The Board of Education annually shall adopt a legislative agenda describing legislative positions and objectives that it supports.

The Board of Education annually shall appoint two legislative liaisons to serve as its representatives for the district's legislative effort. They shall report regularly to the entire Board of Education.

The superintendent or designee shall direct and coordinate the district's legislative agenda and is authorized to represent the Board of Education's legislative agenda and establish its legislative positions in support of that agenda.

All memberships with any legislative/legislative advocacy organizations by the district or an employee representing the district shall have prior approval by the Board of Education.
