

SCHOOL BOARD MEMBERSHIPS

Membership in recognized associations shall be maintained by the schools for several reasons including:

1. The inservice education benefits to the staff and Board which come from participating in meetings, conferences, clinics and conventions.
2. Access to the communication media of such associations such as newsletters, periodicals and advisory services.
3. Representation in action affecting education in general and the school community in particular.

The board in maintaining such membership in no way abdicates its authority over and responsibility for the schools of the community as outlined in law and board policy.

The superintendent is authorized to request funds in each annual budget for such memberships and for paying the costs of adequate participation of staff and board members in the activities of such associations to achieve the purposes listed above.
