

Bristol Bears' Reading Club



At Bristol Elementary School of the Arts, we have a school-wide reading program called the Bristol Bears' Reading Club. Reading logs are developed for each grade. Students are required to read (or be read to) for at least 15 minutes for 5 out of 7 days each week. In grades Kindergarten and 1st, the student draws a picture of what they have read about. For grades 2nd-5th, students are to write a summary of what they read. This log is **DUE EVERY TUESDAY** (Wednesday, if there is no school on Monday). Students are eligible for monthly prizes provided they miss only one weekly log per month. This not only helps students with their reading and comprehension skills but with their ability to summarize what they have read.
