



Colorado Springs School District 11 Bond Construction Program Monthly “Snap-Shot” June 1, 2007



McAuliffe Elementary is moving into the final phases of the project. Classrooms in the south academic wing are done and are in “punch-list”. The north academic wing and center core including the gym, kitchen and cafeteria are right behind. The exterior site work is moving along with curbs, concrete and initial paving in. The playground equipment should be coming in next week followed by the final grading for the athletic field and then final landscaping. Furniture is on order for July and then it’s set up and move in!

Freedom Elementary is coming along nicely both inside and out. It has one large academic wing that includes many core functions and a west gym, cafeteria wing. Most classrooms on the first floor are into the final finish stage, and the second floor, core and common areas are close behind. Exterior site grading is nearly done, and the parking lot curbs are in with the paving scheduled for next week. The heavy rains did slow us down, but the school will finish on time for a fall opening.



The **Doherty High School** addition is now moving fast with the front face all that’s left to have it fully “dried in”. Classrooms on the first floor are nearly done and those on the second floor are framed in and now drywalling. Since school let out, the renovation of the existing school areas has taken off. The areas were cleared last weekend and demolition is in full swing. The swimming pool is getting a complete new deck and other repairs and the new north main entrance is well along.

The “open-concept” renovations for **Bristol, Columbia, Washington** and **Wilson** elementaries are well under way. The demo stage has been completed and all are now into the reconstruction phase. Washington (left) continues to make great progress with the geo-exchange well field done. Mechanical systems are progressing, and the new interior walls going into the finishing stage. In addition to new walls, Columbia (right top) is getting some new windows and doorways. The stud walls are going into Wilson (right bottom) and Bristol (below) is following close behind.



The **Holmes Middle School** renovation is still in the demolition phase, except for the geo-exchange well field, where a third of the 120 300 foot deep wells are in. Ceilings throughout the building are coming down to accommodate the new heating and air-condition system, and the old boiler room has been cleared for the new equipment.

After some initial delays because of the rains, the new **Garry Berry Stadium** locker room facility is going up fast. The equipment storage area is at full height



and the block work on the locker rooms is progressing nicely. This facility will take a big load off of Wasson.

Other big projects starting this summer include:

- Mitchell HS — renovations; add air-conditioning and new athletic field
- Coronado High School renovations new science rooms and auditorium
- Palmer High School addition and renovations
- North Middle School renovations
- Jackson and Rogers elementary schools add air-conditioning
- The technology INET wide area fiber-optic network
