SECOND GRADE

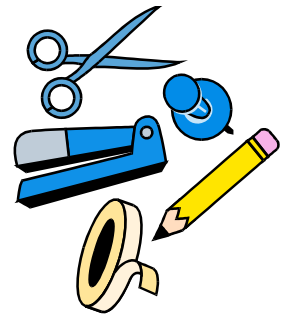
2 boxes wide markers, classic colors
