Check-out limits and loan periods

Limit of 100 total items per account

books, books on CD, audios, magazines 10¢ per day per item
(back issues), CD-ROMs no limit 3 weeks
CDs and VHS videos 10 1 week
DVDs 5 1 week
eBooks, eAudios 3 3 weeks
Rapid Reads 2 1 week

Notify the Library immediately if you change your address or if your card is lost or stolen, because you are responsible for all materials checked out on your card until it is reported. A replacement fee is charged for lost cards.

Fines for overdue materials

books, books on CD, audios, magazines, CDs 10¢ per day per item
 DVDs, VHS videos and CD-ROMs 25¢ per day per item
 lost or damaged materials list price per item
 If an overdue item is returned within a three-day grace period, the fine is excused. After the third day, fines accumulated from the first day are due and payable.

PPLD uses a collection agency to assist with retrieving overdue materials and fees.

You can check your own Library record to see what you have checked out, what you have on "hold," what's overdue, and if you owe any fines. Go to ppld.org (the Library's website). From the home page, choose "Patron Account Management."

* If you are a Colorado resident and live outside of the Pikes Peak Library District, you can get a Colorado Library Card. For more information, stop by the Circulation Desk at any library listed on the back of this brochure or call 531-6333, x2383.

- If you live in El Paso County (except Manitou Springs or Widefield School District 3*), fill out the application in this brochure and take it to any Pikes Peak Library District location.
- You also need to bring picture identification and verification of current permanent address (like a driver's license or bill addressed to you).

Here's how to get a library card:

I accept responsibility for all materials borrowed on this card and for any fines or fees incurred. I will also promptly report a lost or stolen card as well as any address changes.
