

SY2008-2009 School Meal Programs Pricing and Availability Information

Cafeteria services for schools with school lunch programs will begin on the first regularly scheduled full day of classes.

The cost of a full lunch, including milk, is as follows:

Healthy, tasty, and fun food and beverages are also available A la Carte at all middle and high schools.

For students who were enrolled in the district database and who qualified for meal benefits on the last day of school in the previous year, all free and reduced price meals will be continued for up to 30 school days in the new school year or until a new form has been completed and approved or denied. Households are required by USDA federal guidelines to fill out new applications each school year.

Free and reduced price meal applications will be mailed to households in the district the first part of August. Applications will also be available in school offices. Only one application per household should be turned in to the school office. All students who are not classified as "free" or "reduced" from the prior year are "full pay" until determination on free or reduced meals has been made. Parents are responsible for providing lunches from home or lunch money during this time.

Families are encouraged to pre-pay for student meals. Pre-payment may be made at either the school or www.d11.org/fns/prepay.htm or by calling 1-866-896-7594, where a credit card may be used. Student meal account balances may be viewed at "no charge" and account deposits may be made by simply registering at the Official Payments web site through www.d11.org/fns/prepay.htm.
