



Colorado Springs Fire Department' Student Fire and Life Safety Program

Purpose: Introduce basic fire and life safety behaviors to kindergarten students.

Description: A complete Fire and Life Safety Program is available to you kindergarten classrooms. Safety behaviors taught will include: crawling low under smoke, the use and importance of smoke alarms, calling 9-1-1 in an emergency, the meaning of EXIT signs, get out and stay out, and matches and lighters are tools not toys. Kindergarten students will meet Sparky the Firedog (puppet) and learn that firefighters are friends. The presentation is interactive and will encourage children to practice a fire drill, make a promise to never touch matches and lighters and uses repetitive exercises to emphasize fire safety messages.

Audience: Kindergarteners

Size: 1-2 classrooms per session
