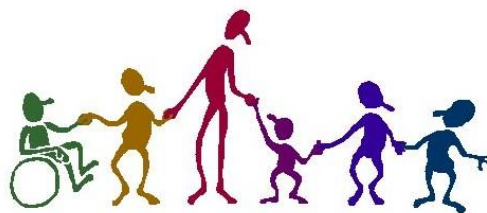
Ashley West – First Grade Teacher

Hello,

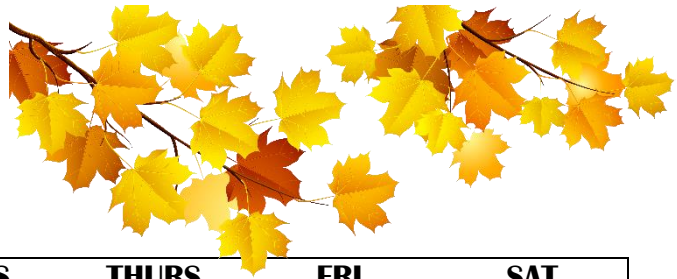
