

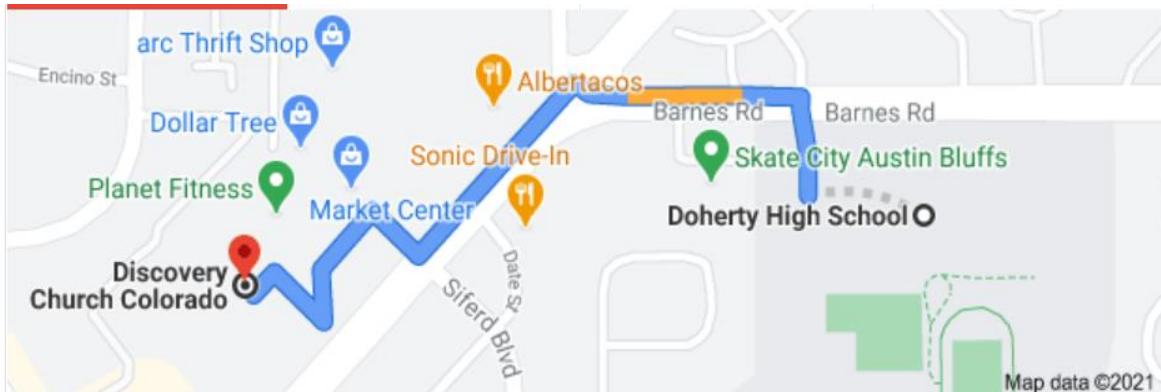
## In Person AP Exams

### Dear AP Student,

Advanced Placement exams start on May 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2021. The schedule for in-person exams is at the end of this letter. Below are instructions for those of you taking the in-person exams. You can access your personalized AP exam schedule on your College Board account as well.

### Location

Most exams will be at **Discovery Church located at 4304 Austin Bluffs Parkway**. See map below. The exceptions are Spanish and German exams, which will be held at Doherty High School in the Blue Lab. If you are testing with any accommodations, you will receive personalized information as to where you will take your exam.



### Time

- Morning exams will begin at 8 am. **You need to arrive at 7:00 am**. Afternoon exams will begin at 12 pm and **you will need to arrive for check in at 11:15 am**. You can expect exams to take 3-4 hours, please consult with your AP teacher for exam length.

### Missed Classes

- You will be excused from your classes for the full day on the day that you have an exam. If you fail to report to the exam, you will not be excused from your classes. It is your responsibility to work with your teachers for anything you miss on those days.

## In Person AP Exams

### Bring/Not Bring

The following are items you should bring and not bring. If you bring any prohibited items they will be stored in a bin with your name on it just outside the testing room and will be unsupervised.

Use this <a href="#">LINK</a> to see the calculator policies for each course. Speak with your teacher.</li><li>• Ruler or straightedge if taking AP Physics</li><li>• Government-issued or school-issued photo ID.</li><li>• College Board SSD Accommodations Letter if you are approved for accommodations.</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Books, compasses, correction fluid, dictionaries, highlighters, or notes.</li><li>• Mechanical pencils, No. 3 pencils, or colored pencils.</li><li>• Rulers or straightedges (unless for Physics)</li><li>• Protractors</li><li>• Scratch paper</li><li>• Computers or calculators (unless for exams mentioned)</li><li>• Watches that beep or have an alarm</li><li>• Food or drink</li><li>• Ear plugs or buds</li><li>• Phones</li></ul>
