

Dear Coronado Seniors and Parents,

Last year's juniors missed their opportunity to take the SAT at school in April of 2020. Because of this the Colorado Department of Education (CDE) has provided an opportunity for the now seniors to take the SAT free of charge this fall. Please read this email carefully to choose what option works best for you.

The SAT will be administered the Saturdays below at various test centers around the state. You may register for any of these dates free of charge using a voucher you can request from us.

For security reason we will email the voucher to the students' school email address.

Directions are attached that walk you through how to register. You will need your voucher code and Coronado's school code which is 060273.

Coronado has requested to become an administration sight but has not been approved at this time. When/if we are approved, we will send out communication as quickly as possible.

If you have already registered for one of these tests you can contact college board and see if they will give you a refund and use the voucher instead. This is completely up to college board who administers the SAT and Coronado has no say in the matter.

At this time, you should consider these 3 options.

1. Sign up for the test as soon as possible for the test date that works best for you. Convenient test centers may be hard to come by so check the website often to see what is available. This is a good option if you know you are going to college and need results as soon as possible for college admissions or scholarships.
2. Wait and see if Coronado becomes a test sight. This option may be good for you if you want to take it, but there is no rush. You may be planning on going to college but do not plan on applying soon. You may be more concerned about convenience of the testing

site then the timing of the test. We will update you as soon as we have more information.

3. Not take the SAT. If you are not planning on going to college directly after high school, there may be no reason to take the SAT. You are not required to take it. Also, many colleges and scholarships are not requiring it currently because of the pandemic. If we do not here from you to request a voucher, we will assume you are not taking it.

Feel free to contact one of the people above if you have questions about whether you should take the SAT or not or how the voucher system works.

If you have accommodations for taking state test such as the SAT you should contact Cody.Eden@d11.org before you register to get your SSD number. Not all accommodations are available at Saturday test sites. Contact Mr. Eden with questions.

SAT with Essay is available at some test sites and dates. The voucher will cover the cost of SAT with Essay. If you are not sure if you need to take SAT with essay, contact your college/university or Mr. Eden for guidance.
