9th-12th Grades Credits:

Child & Adolescent Development explores the principles and theories of child growth & development from birth through adolescence. This course focuses on the physical, social, emotional and cognitive domains of development and their application to teaching and caring for children.

Relationships addresses knowledge & skills needed for healthy relationships. Includes an understanding of both *Intrapersonal* + *Interpersonal* relationships.

Work-based Learning:

Classroom Internship (30hr)

This course prepares students to work as an educational assistant in a school setting supporting students with individualized learning needs. With successful completion of the course, students will be prepared to enter the workforce as an education assistant. The course provides training in instructional methods, use of technology, and behavior management techniques.
