The District has developed tools to help students guide their own learning within the content they are currently learning in their classes.

During the time we are offsite, students will be able to reach out to their teachers for help, guidance, and support with their work:

- Each day of distance learning students should choose at least one activity from each subject area column (Math, Reading, Writing, Science/Social and Specials).
 - o OR: Students can design their own choice board on the blank copy provided.
 - o OR: Students can log in to Khan Academy and record activity/time spent on the page provided.
- Please log the amount of time it took to complete the activity and have caregiver/parent sign the bottom of the form.
- Students must return their activity log to their teacher within 1 week upon return to school.

Our Kinder-through-5th Grade students received their Distance Learning packets on 3/13/2020.
