

Free Speech Organizations That Help Those Individuals and Groups Whose Free Speech Has Been Denied

[The Foundation for Individual Rights in Education](#) (FIRE) focuses specifically on protecting free speech on college campuses. Its mission is to “defend and sustain the individual rights of students and faculty members at America’s colleges and universities. These rights include freedom of speech, freedom of association, due process, legal equality, religious liberty, and sanctity of conscience—the essential qualities of liberty.”

The [Institute for Justice](#) (IJ) is another public interest law firm that “litigates to protect commercial, occupational and political speech.” The organization seeks to “defend the free flow of information—information that is indispensable to our democratic form of government and to our free enterprise economy.”

The [Pacific Legal Foundation is doing its part](#), defending speech from government censorship based on its content, expanding legal protections for professional and commercial speech, and preserving the right not to be spoken for.
