Project Topic: Video Game Design

1. You read a book called *The Ultimate Guide to Video Game Writing and Design* by Flint Dille. The book was published in 2007 by Lone Eagle which is in Los Angeles, California.
2. On October 13, 2016 you interviewed Jarrod Kozeal (a Video Game design expert who works for Vicon). You met him in person at an event in Denver, CO. *Jarrod is the interviewee.
3. You read a paper magazine article titled “I Can See the Future from Here” in *Popular Mechanics* about the future of virtual reality goggles. The article was in the October 2016 issue. The author is Kevin Dupzyk. The article was on pages 76-81.
4. You visited a website article about the HoloLens on October 27, 2016.
