Thank you for support through frustrations with technology as we began this school year!

Good things shared - we are all so happy to have students back in the building! Schoology is also working and families are getting used to it.

SAC Chair - Works with the principal each month to set the agenda for the upcoming meeting. Ashley Wensch volunteered and was unanimously approved.

Return Plan: All students will have the option to return to in person, all day learning the week of September 21 on a staggered schedule:

K- return on 21st

1st - return on 22nd

2nd - return on 23rd

3rd - return on 24th

4th and 5th - return on 25th

Families will need to choose to return in person or remain online through the end of the first quarter, ending October 15. Due to staffing, we will not be able to accommodate students going back and forth from online to in person.

COVID funds: We have money to use specifically related to the pandemic - about \$18,000

-ordered touchless paper towel dispensers - about \$4,000

-ordered touchless soap dispensers - about \$2,000

-purchased art supplies that were sent home - about \$680.00

-purchased social distancing decals throughout the building - stand here, one way arrows, 6 ft - \$440.00

-ordered chromebook cases - \$4,460

-ordered Ipad cases - about \$1,200

-purchased general supplies - \$665.00 (office and classroom necessities)

-water bottle station request - will get a quote

-additional keypad for rear intermediate side exterior door to maintain one way traffic flow - have the estimate, \$1,750- need to order

-Electrostatic machine to spray SAO - awaiting estimate
