Welcome to Colorado Springs School District 11! Thank you for choosing to be part of the District 11 family!

New Teacher & Specialized Service Professionals (SSP) Orientation:

- ALL new teachers and new special service providers are required to attend every day of *New Teacher Orientation (NTO)* August 5 –7, 2019. See specific details on page 3 for dates & times. Be sure to register for each day's training! NTO is identified by the District 11 Master Agreement as a condition of employment and compensation is not provided on these days.
- If you have been hired as a new Library Technology Educator (LTE) or preschool teacher, it is *highly recommended* you attend the targeted trainings aligned to your role prior to NTO. See information on page 2. The department facilitator will be in close contact with you. There is NO registration link for LTE or preschool teachers to complete.
- *Highly recommended*, optional trainings, will help prepare new teachers by increasing their knowledge and understanding of district elementary curriculum. "Wonders" training introduces new teachers to the K-5 reading curriculum. Math Expressions introduces new teachers to the K-5 math curriculum. These trainings begin as early as August 1, 2019.
