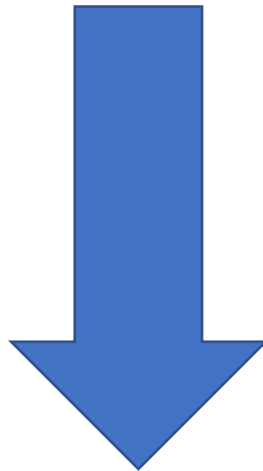
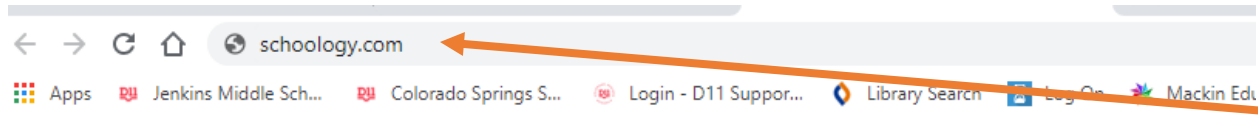


Dear Jaguar Nation Families,

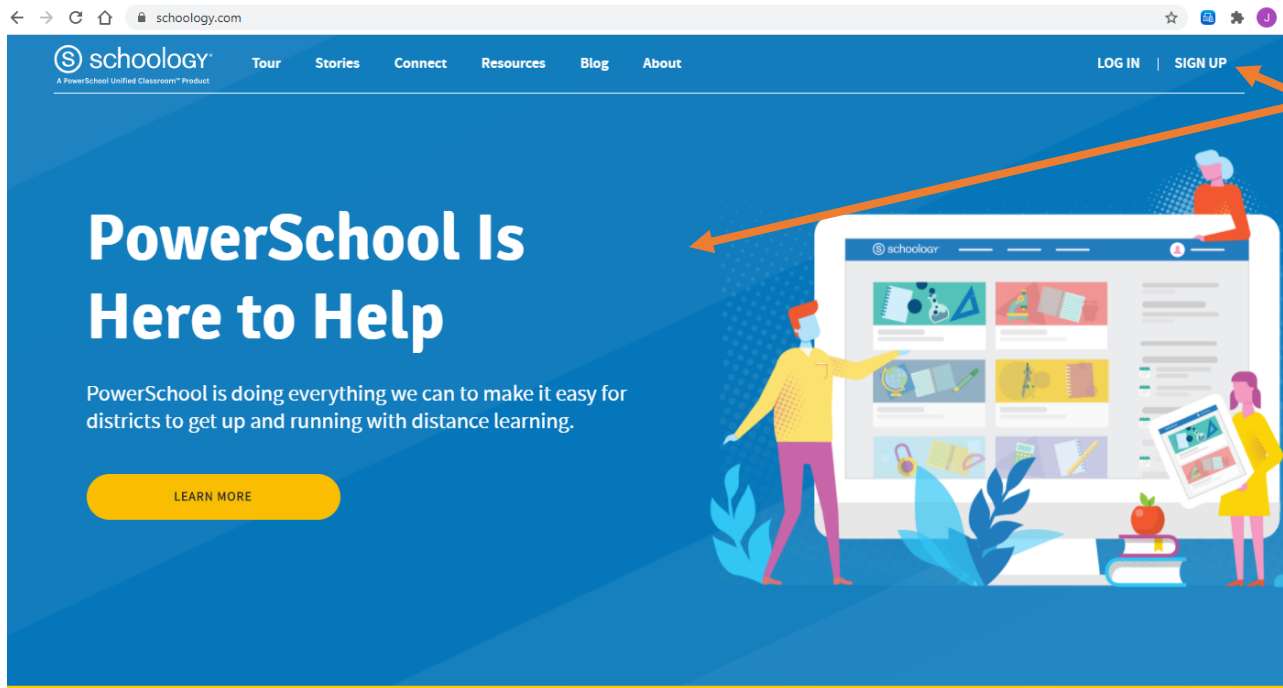

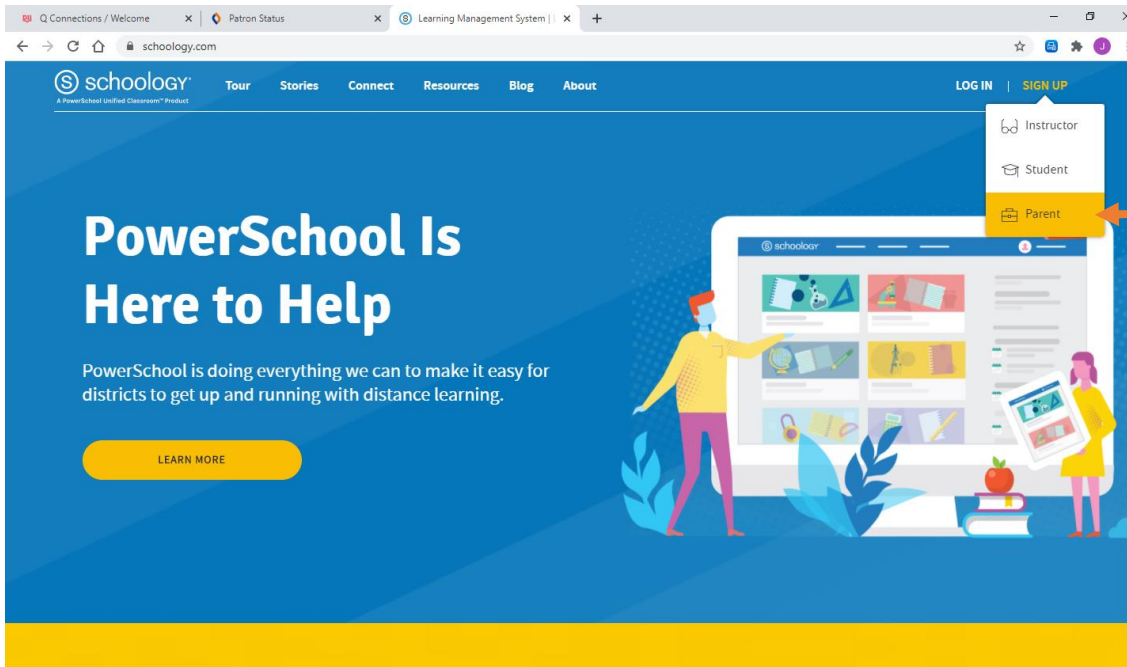


1. Go to www.schoology.com

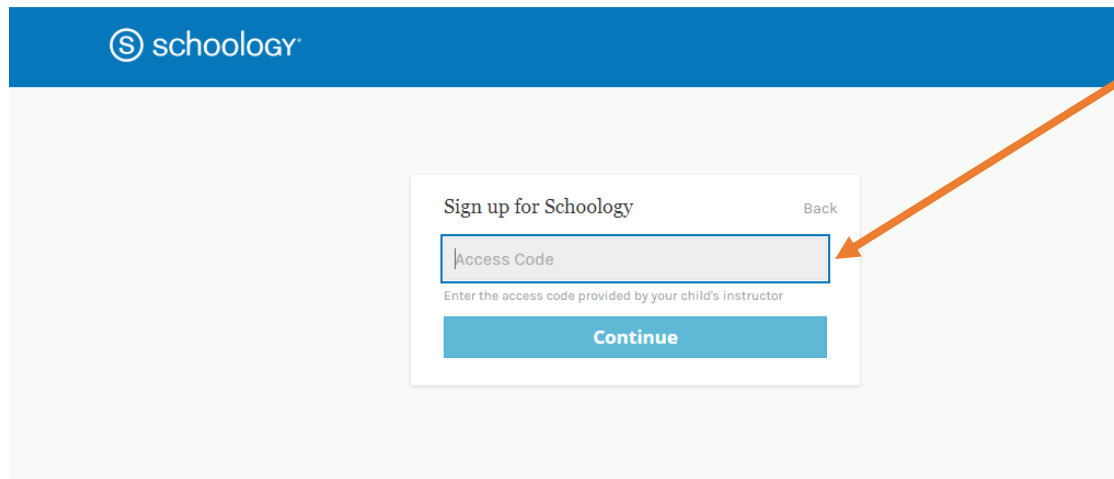


2. This is what the page should look like when you go to Schoology.com.

3. Press "SIGN UP" in the top-right-hand corner.

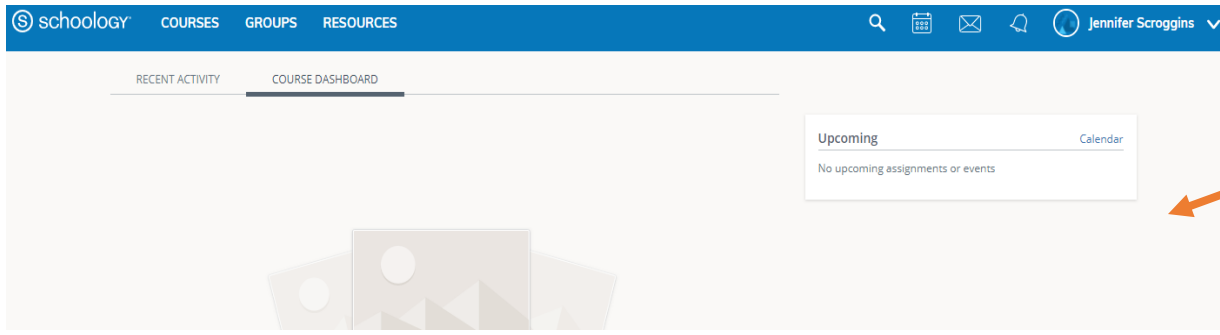

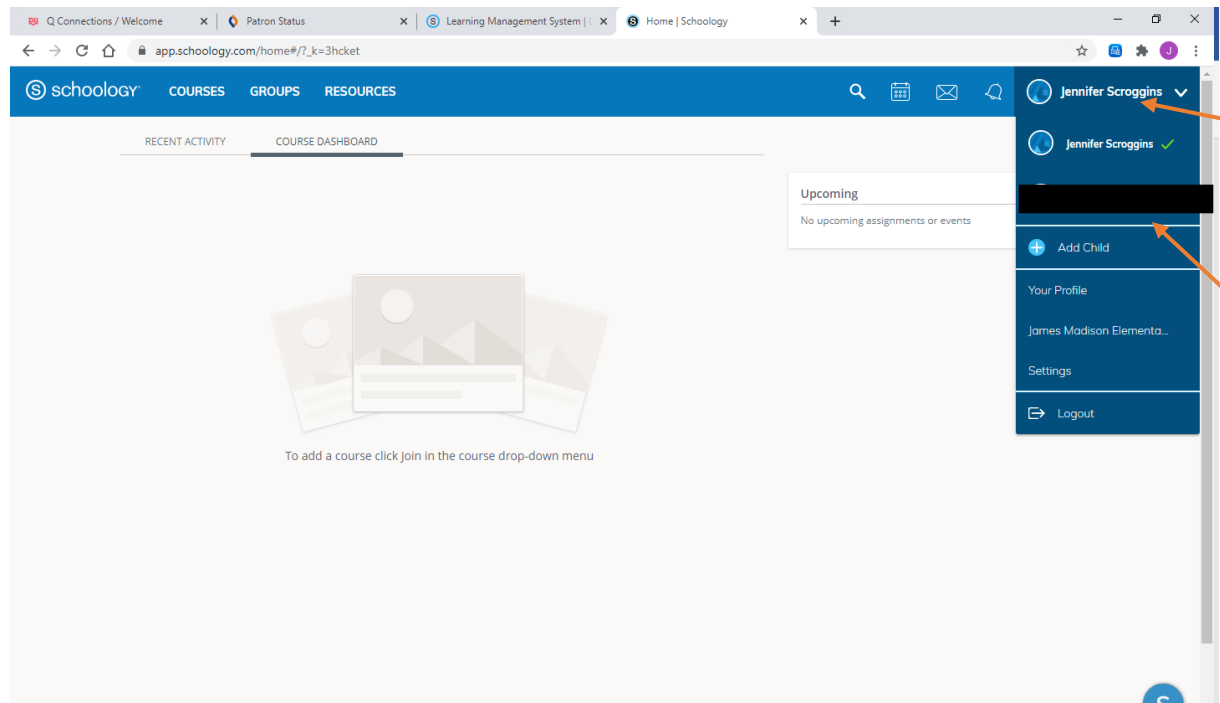

7. This is an example of the what should be filled out. Make sure that you click the two blue boxes, and then click "REGISTER".
