As our District Superintendent has shared, COVID-19 continues to surge throughout our region and the State, as a result, we had to move into a district-wide remote instructional model. It has always been our desire to have students back in our classrooms and schools, but we want to do so in the safest way possible. We will continue to operate in a remote learning mode from now through Martin Luther King Day.

Here is a bit more specific information:

- District 11 elementary schools will continue to have a full day of asynchronous learning on Mondays to provide planning time for teachers. Students will remain home on these days once we return to in-person learning.
- We will be returning to in-person learning after Martin Luther King Day on Monday, January 19th.
- Grab-n-Go curbside service will be available from 11:00 - 12:30 pm through Friday, January 15th. This service will provide free breakfast and lunch for our families to pick up during that window of time.
- Please reach out to your classroom teacher if you have any questions regarding your child's daily schedule or classroom information.

This timeline will be flexible and dependent on changes to our county's color dial and recommendations from El Paso County Public Health. We want to have a plan that is sustainable so all students may return and stay in school. We appreciate your continued patience as we navigate the remainder of this school year together.
