Remote Schedule

Monday will run as an asynchronous learning day for all Sabin and D11 middle school students. Students will follow the enclosed bell schedule for their grade level using Remote Learning methods – Asynchronous activities in Schoology.

Asynchronous Learning





Asynchronous Learning denotes learning without Live Instruction - Independent activities via Schoology in Advisory, Core, and Exploratory classes. Monday attendance will be taken based on completion of assigned activities for the Advisory period. Independent activities in Core and Exploratory classes will be graded based on students' mastery and demonstrated competency for the specific activity.

Synchronous Learning

Synchronous Learning denotes learning with Live Instruction – Learning and activities that are directed and facilitated by the Sabin teacher while video conferencing in WebEx.

Full Remote Learning

This choice will allow all students to continue to follow a schedule from home using Remote Learning methods.

- **Thursday - Periods 1, 2, 3, 4**
All 6th grade, 7th grade & 8th grade students are logged in to class from home working synchronous via WebEx with their teacher.
- **Friday - Periods 1, 6, 7, 8**
All 6th grade, 7th grade & 8th grade students are logged in to class from home working synchronous via WebEx with their teacher.
