Subject: Management Directive-Incident Command Training

Management Directive #: MD-A3


Purpose:

Colorado Revised Statute 22-32-109.1(4) requires that key emergency school personnel complete courses provided by the Federal Emergency Management Agency's (FEMA) Emergency Management Institute or by institutions of higher education in the state system of community and technical colleges. These courses as related to the National Incident Management System (NIMS) count toward the professional development requirements of a licensed employee.

The two courses recommended are IS-100.SCa Introduction to the Incident Command System for Schools and IS-362.a Multi-Hazard Emergency Planning for Schools. Both courses are provided online at the FEMA website.

Directive:

All school administrators who serve on the school's Safety Committee as denoted in the School Crisis Plan or serve on the District's Emergency Crisis Operation Team (ECOT) must complete FEMA online courses IS-100.b and IS-362.a and submit the certificate of completion to the District 11 Professional Development Department. This a onetime requirement.
