- Interested in learning more about it



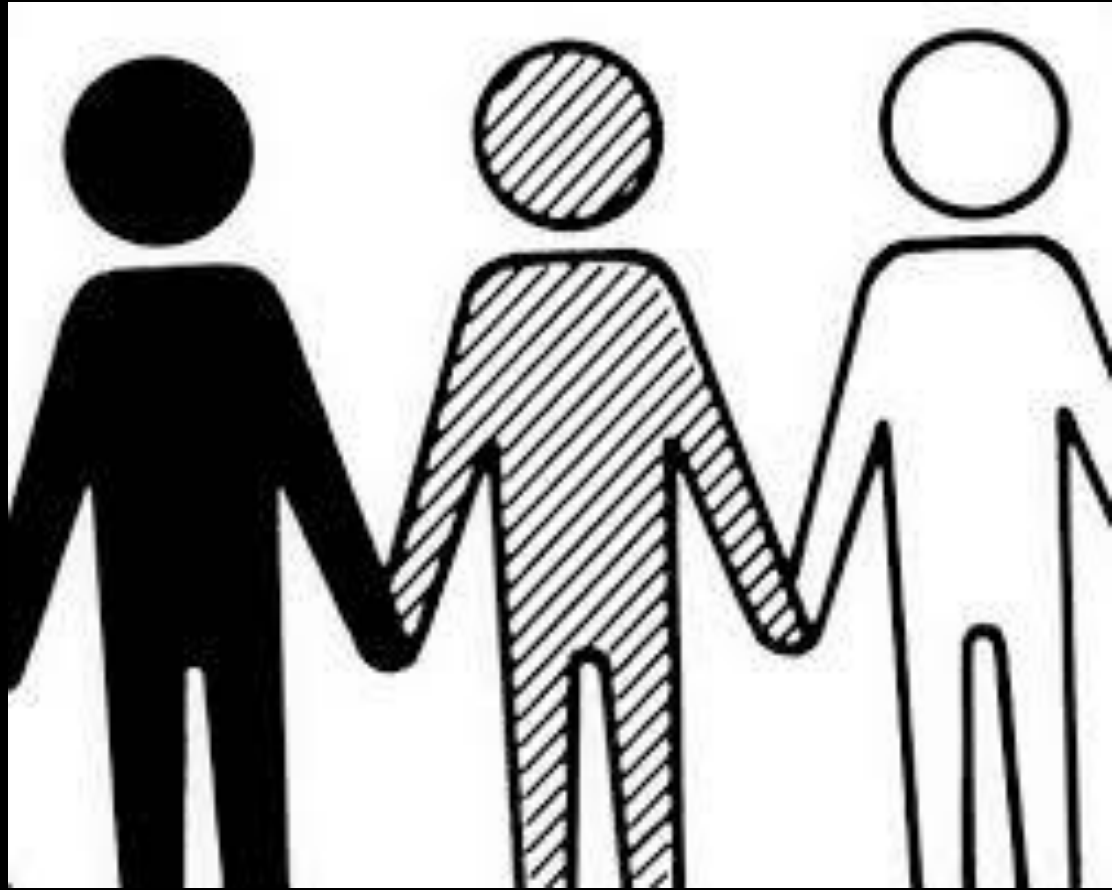

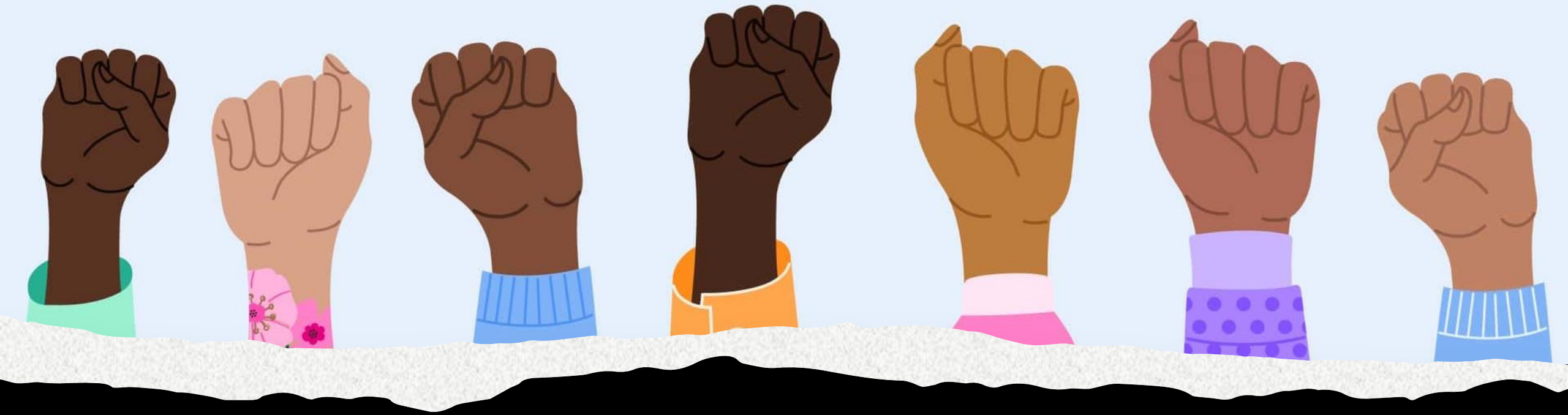
- Fairness and Development
