

**RESOLUTION 2016-1
CALL FOR NOMINATIONS FOR SCHOOL DIRECTORS
AND PARTICIPATION IN THE 2015 COORDINATED ELECTION
COLORADO SPRINGS SCHOOL DISTRICT 11
EL PASO COUNTY, COLORADO**

Whereas, Colorado Springs School District 11 (the District), is required to hold elections on a biennial basis for vacant seats on the Board of Education, and is seeking candidates for such vacant seats (Call for Nominations); and

Whereas, at this election four directors will be elected to the Colorado Springs School District 11 Board of Education for one term of four years apiece. To be qualified, a candidate must have been a registered elector of the school district for at least twelve consecutive months before the election; and

Whereas, a person who desires to be a candidate for school director shall file a written notice of intention to be a candidate, and a nomination petition in accordance with law. Such petitions may be obtained from the Secretary to the Board of Education beginning August 5, 2015, and returned no later than 5:00 p.m. on August 28, 2015.

Now therefore it be resolved, that Colorado Springs School District 11 (the District), in the County of El Paso and State of Colorado, confirms their participation in the Coordinated Election to be held on Tuesday, November 3, 2015, and that the District will follow the election provisions of the Code, in accordance with the terms and conditions of the Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA);
