

## **DISASTER PLANS**

It is the responsibility of every Colorado Springs School District 11 (the District) staff member to be aware of the policies, regulations and procedures established for each emergency which foreseeably may affect his or her area of activity.

It is the further responsibility of every principal and other administrator to be aware of laws and District policies and regulations pertaining to such foreseeable emergencies. In conformance with these, principals and administrators should have a plan of action adapted to local conditions to be carried out in each emergency. The first concern of the plan will be the safety and orderly conduct of students.; The second concern will be the safety of all personnel. The third concern will be the minimizing of damage or loss of property. The District's Commander of Security Operations will act as advisor to principals and other administrators on the development of crisis and emergency plans. The Commander of Security Operations will serve as liaison to local law enforcement and emergency arrangement officials.

It is the responsibility of the principal or other administrator that students and personnel have prior knowledge of each plan of action sufficient to ensure their maximum safety and order in case an emergency should occur.
