

PROFESSIONAL RESEARCH AND PUBLISHING

Staff members are encouraged to contribute professional articles and news items to local, state and national agencies. All professional articles in which Colorado Springs School District 11 (the District) or any of its separate departments are mentioned, should be cleared through the office of the Superintendent or designee. The appropriate administrator shall advise the Superintendent of the validity, reliability and general information contained therein.

Professional materials and items written or produced for the news media or for publication locally, statewide or on a national basis by a District employee shall become property of the District if said materials or items are prepared during hours working for the District or using property owned by the District.

The American Psychological Association's code of ethics for research precautions and publication credit shall be followed when applicable.
