

**EXTENDED STUDIES Program  
(Requirements and Procedures for Participation in the  
EXTENDED STUDIES Program)**

Extended studies opportunities are courses that are usually taken at the high school where the student is enrolled, and for which the student has the opportunity to earn both Carnegie units (high school credit) and college credit. Students must meet both the Local Education Provider (LEP) and Institution of Higher Education (IHE) qualifications for enrollment.

Extended Studies may be offered both on and off campus.

Successful completion of extended study course work may be included on the student's official high school transcript.

Students and their parents/guardians shall receive information regarding guaranteed transfer and requirements statewide, and the availability of other credit-bearing postsecondary options per Policy IHCDA.

In instances where the District may pay full or partial tuition and fees, students must complete a Postsecondary Participation Agreement in accordance to a timeline established by the District. The principal/designee of the student's home school shall approve all applications. (The Postsecondary Participation Agreement can be found on the District's website for Concurrent Enrollment by going to [d11.org](http://d11.org), departments, Career and Technical Education.)

The principal/designee shall provide the Superintendent/designee a list of students who earn postsecondary credit in accordance to a schedule that suits enrollment timelines established by postsecondary partners.

**Payment of Tuition or Equivalent Costs**

The District may pay the tuition or equivalent costs for academic credit for qualified students participating in programs in which postsecondary credit is available.

**Transportation**

The District may elect to provide or pay for transportation to the institution of higher education. Transportation is not guaranteed.
