

HOW TO EMBED A MEDIAL VIDEO ON YOUR WEBSITE

- 1) Open your Blackboard Site Manager and go to the page where you want to embed the video
- 2) Insert an EMBED CODE app
 - a. Click Manage Apps & Layouts
 - b. Click Add App
 - c. Click Embed Code
 - d. Click Create New
 - e. Give it a name
 - f. Click Create
 - g. Click I'm Done

- 3) Open the app by clicking on the gray box
- 4) When you upload a video to Medial, it will email you the embed code after it has completed encoding your video. You will paste that embed code into the app.
