9TH-12TH GRADE PHYSICAL EDUCATION CONTRACT



The following policies are also listed on the Doherty website for your reference.

- Each course consists of three six-week units of activities.
- Students must be prepared for class each day:
 - Each student **must** have appropriate clothing (athletic shoes, t-shirt, and sweats or athletic shorts) for class. An exception to the dress-out policy is made for off-campus activities.
 - Each student **must** have a **combination lock** to secure his or her belongings in the locker rooms. (DHS staff STRONGLY discourages students sharing locks)
 - **Please make sure that you are securing your personal belongings appropriately.**
- Grades are recorded in Q weekly and consist of a composite of the following criteria:
 - Active participation, to include being on time, dressing out, and being active in all activities during the class period.
 - Absences and makeups will affect a student’s grade in the following ways:
 - If a student is tardy (more than 5 minutes after the allotted dress out time), he or she will lose half of the points for the day and cannot make up those points.
 - If a student has an excused absence, he or she loses the points for the day **UNTIL** point recovery is completed.
 - ****NOTE**: 6 non- participatory days (not dressed out, no participation or unexcused absences) in any unit will result in a failing grade being issued to that student.**
 - **Must pass all 3 sections of PE 9 to obtain credit for the semester**
 - **Please remember that students need 3 THREE semesters of Physical Education to graduate.**
 - Each **excused** absence may be made up by communicating with your teacher to determine the appropriate method or activities to recover points.

I have read and understand the **contract requirements and grading scales** for Physical Education as outlined on these pages and explained in class. I understand that if my son or daughter brings an electronic device or personal items (including but not limited to iPods, cell phones, jewelry, calculators, headphones, cameras, clothing, purses, monies, and backpacks) to Physical Education class and are left unlocked or locked in the locker rooms or any of the Physical Education facilities, **Doherty High School is NOT responsible for the return, replacement, or payment of said articles.**
