

Steps: EBSCO Database Search

```
graph TD; A[Search & Think & Find] --> B[EBSCO Database Searching]; B --> C[When you find an article to use:]; C --> A;
```

When you find an article to use:

1. Click on Article to see all (Full Text already checked)
2. **IMPORTANT:** Click on Permalink (Don't save regular URL). Save Permalink (Be organized: OneNote. One Page per Source. Permalink, Title, Author at top. Take notes on that page).
3. Save Article or Print Article or Read online. Take notes to help you write (*prove your claim*)
4. Cite: Use Cite Button (Copy and Paste into your Bibliography [Works Cited])

EBSCO Database Searching

1. North Web//Library//EBSCO
2. ALL EBSCO Databases (or narrow search to a specific field)
3. What KEY WORDS will you use to search?
4. REFINE RESULTS— Current Search—check the box that says “Scholarly (Peer Reviewed) Journals”
