

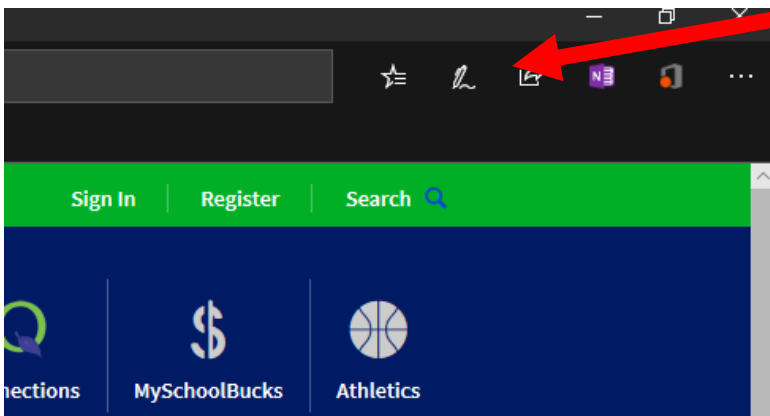

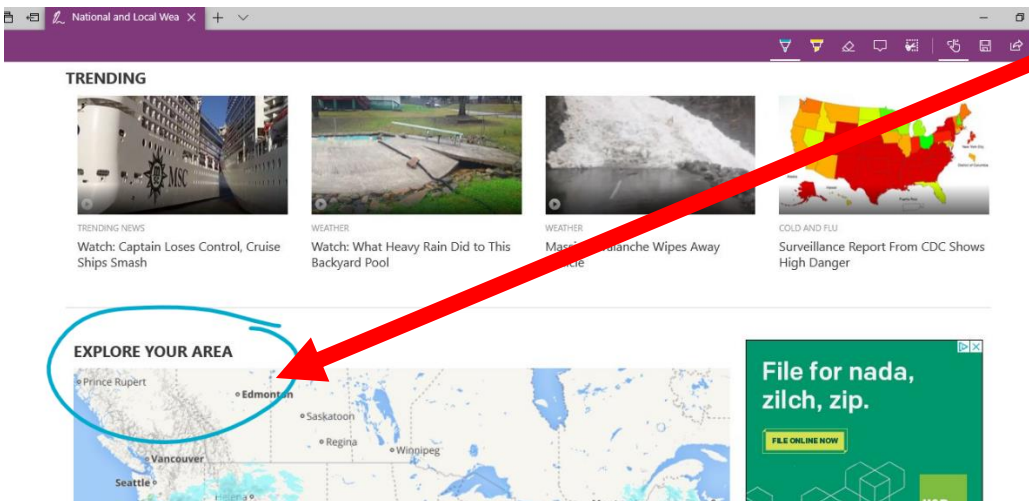
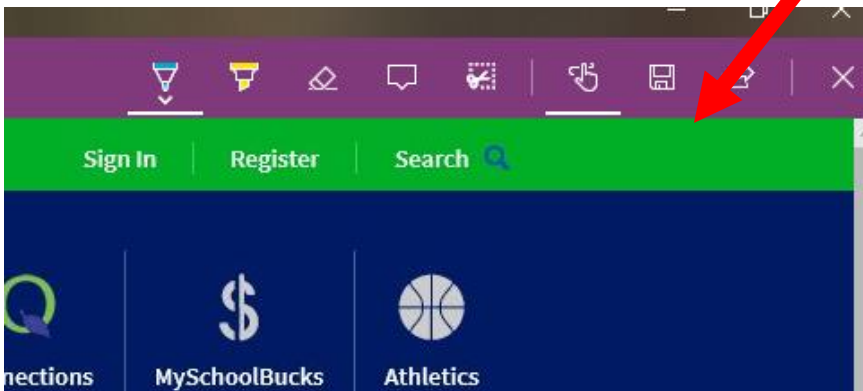

Look, I just circled this part of the live website with Edge!

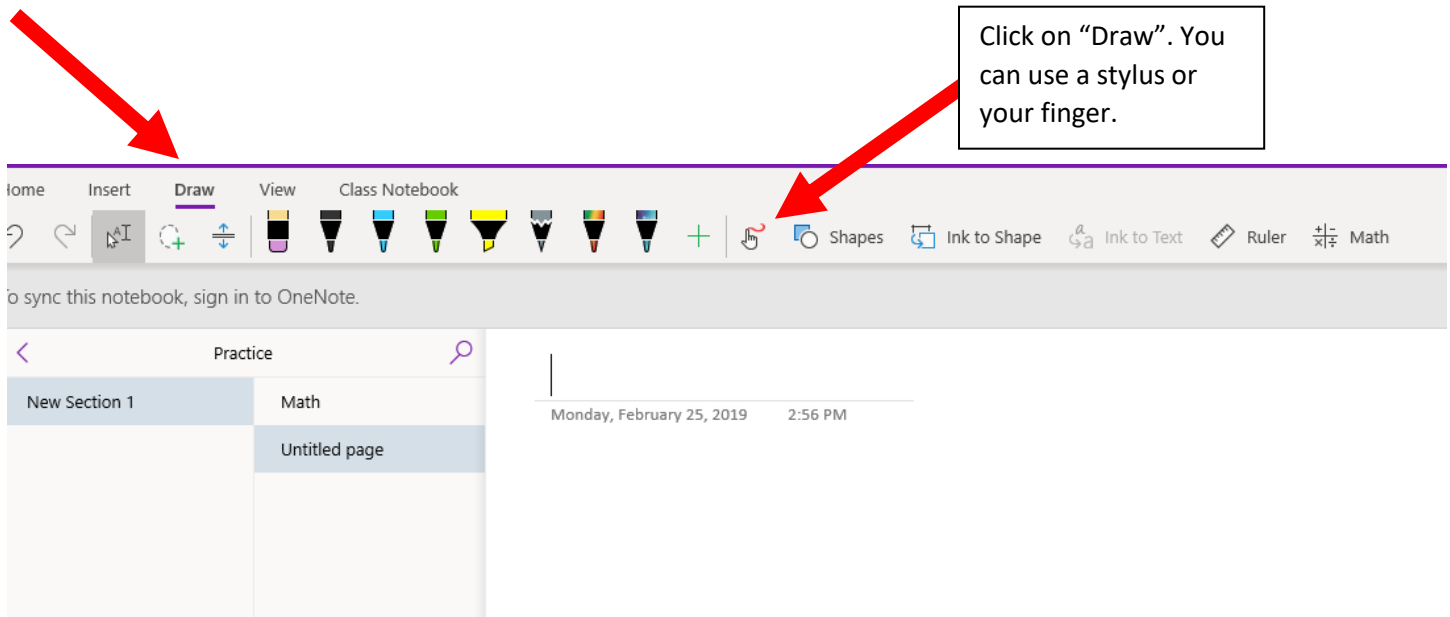
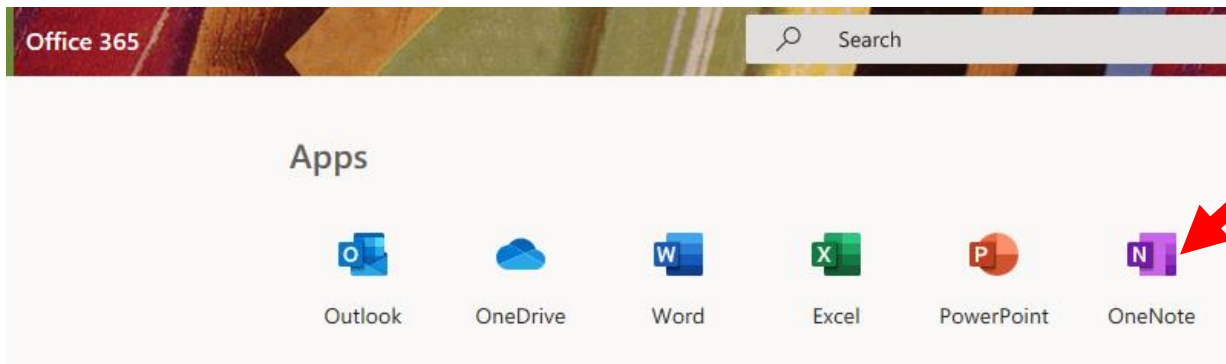


OneNote
