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Student Webex Guidance from Steven Lambert

Here's a follow-up for students using Webex. Only teachers have been set up with accounts for hosting meetings. What this means for students is that they shouldn't try to "sign in".

- For students on a phone or tablet, click on "Join Meeting" – ignore the "Sign in" button
- For students using a browser on their desktop or laptop, if you get a pop up asking you to sign in, close that pop up. Back in the original window, choose "Join from your browser" or "Download it now"

Students will still need to enter their d11 email address to *join* their first meeting, but they won't actually be 'signing in'. Parents can choose to create a Webex account if they wish to host meetings, but that's not necessary for students to use the app. This is preferable because students accessing using their D11 email address so that their names show up correctly in the meeting.
