PPLA is a CDE-approved Principal/Administrator Induction program. When the program is completed, the inductee submits the Induction Certificate of Completion to CDE to advance to a Professional License. Attendance and time in class is critical.

To earn a Professional Principal/Administrator License, inductees are required to attend **ALL** classes. Plan on classes to be in-person. PPLA partners will notify inductees in advance if class is to be held virtually.

If an inductee misses a class for any reason (district business, illness, or other scenario), the inductee will collaborate with the PPLA partners and their district supervisor to make up the content of the class. The inductee should discuss PPLA content with their district-provided mentor to bring the relevance and application of the learning to the inductees' daily work experience.
