

LEGISLATIVE PROGRAM

The Colorado Springs School District 11 Board of Education (the Board) shall annually adopt a legislative agenda describing legislative positions and objectives that it supports.

In addition, the Board shall annually appoint two legislative liaisons to serve as its representatives for Colorado Springs School District 11's (the District) legislative effort. They shall report regularly to the entire Board.

The Superintendent or designee shall coordinate the District's legislative agenda and is authorized to represent the Board's legislative agenda and its legislative positions in support of that agenda.

All memberships with any legislative/legislative advocacy organizations shall have prior approval by the Board. Any employee representing the District regarding legislative matters shall have prior approval by the Board.
