

SUMMER SCHOOL LEARNING PROGRAM

The Colorado Springs School District 11 Board of Education (the Board) recognizes the value of extending the school year learning process for all of Colorado Springs School District 11's (the District's) students. The Board believes that increasing learning opportunities will contribute to accomplishing the district's goal of improving student achievement. Therefore the Board directs the Superintendent or designee to develop and implement a summer learning program that will be available to all students through a variety of methods.

The summer learning program will focus on:

1. Grades 9 – 12. Credit recovery for students to acquire credits toward graduation.
2. Grades K-8. The summer learning program in our elementary and middle schools will serve students and their families wishing to engage in continued learning opportunities.

The fee structure for the Summer Learning Program will be based on the funding available each budget year.

Openings in all summer school positions shall be filled first by teacher applicants already employed by the District. In filling summer school positions, consideration shall be given to a teacher's area of competence, major and minor field of study, and teaching experience.
