

**EXEMPTIONS FROM REQUIRED INSTRUCTION**  
(Physical Education)

Physical education waivers granted for seniors new to the District or for medical or religious reasons may exceed the total of one semester credit of physical education. (See #1, #2 and #3 below.) A total of one credit of physical education may be waived for other reasons (See #4, #5 and #6 below).

Physical education waivers will be considered upon written request to the principal for the following reasons:

1. If a student enters the District as a senior from another school district with fewer physical education requirements and the student needs a full schedule of classes to meet the District's other graduation requirements
2. If a medical statement from a doctor substantiates a health problem which precludes the completion of physical education classes
3. If for religious reasons a parent does not wish to have the student take physical education
4. If a student is taking six classes that are counted in the grade point average
5. If personal hardships such as employment or family illness exist
6. If a student participates in school athletics, cheerleading, marching band or pompon
