A Resolution of Colorado Springs School District 11 authorizing the appointment of a Board Member to serve as the School District representative board member for the Colorado Springs Urban Renewal Authority.

Whereas, the Colorado State Legislature amended state statutes (HB 15-1348) in the 2015 Session to require one commissioner be an elected member of a Board of Education of a School District levying a mill levy within the boundaries of the Urban Renewal Authority area; and

Whereas, the Board now desires to authorize E. James Mason to serve in accordance with such amendment. Now, therefore, be it

Resolved that the Board hereby authorizes E. James Mason to serve as the local school district board member for the Colorado Springs Urban Renewal Authority until such time as he is replaced.






