
Whereas teachers are also necessary and valued coaches, including teacher learning and literacy coaches, to provide professional support for our other teachers; now therefore, be it

In Witness whereof, we have hereunto set our hands and caused the official seal of said school district to be hereunto affixed this 27th day of April, 2016.




