

RESOLUTION 2017-24
Approving One-Year Extension of Charter Contract
for
CIVA Charter High School
January 11, 2017

WHEREAS, on April 13, 2016, the Board of Education (Board) of Colorado Springs School District 11 (District) adopted recommended revisions to Policy LBD, Relations with Charter Schools. The revisions included allowing a charter school whose Annual Performance Review (APR) overall score is 90 percent or higher to be eligible for a one year extension to their current charter contract term, subject to Board approval;

WHEREAS, in accordance with Policy LBD, the contract plus extensions will not exceed 10 years before a contract renewal is required;

WHEREAS, the Board had previously awarded CIVA Charter High School a charter contract for five years, through June 30, 2021;

WHEREAS, the District prepared the 2015-2016 school year APR detailing:
1) academic performance and accreditation status; 2) financial accountability; 3) governance; and
4) school operations;

WHEREAS, CIVA Charter High School received an overall APR score of 96.9%; and


WHEREAS, the Board has considered CIVA Charter High School's APR score and voted favorably upon this resolution.

Resolved that the Board of Education approves the extension of CIVA Charter High School's current contract through June 30, 2022.


