5) Update on ZAP (Zeroes Aren't Permitted)

No one has been hired for the Math Interventionist job because no one has applied. The plan was for the Math Interventionist to run the ZAP program. Since no one has been hired this is not happening currently.

6) Capturing Kids Hearts Data

This is the first year of Sabin using the Capturing Kids Hearts Program. This year the staff has been working on building relationships by meeting and greeting each student. Each classroom is also expected to have a social contract. The CKH program has essential skills to EXCEL, Engage, X-plore, Communicate, Empower, and Launch. Last week some representatives from Capturing Kids Hearts was at Sabin to see how the implementation is going. They found that a lot of teachers are meeting and greeting and using social contracts but not everyone. A survey is going out to teachers to help figure out how their implementation is going. They will be able to get help in areas where they need. From this survey the school will be able to see how the program is going and how we can improve. We will look at this again in April.

7) Discipline Data for January

The January Discipline Data was presented. Below is a summary of the infractions that occurred. The largest category is where teachers are having issues in the classroom with students. The school is seeing quite a few issues with sixth grade girls and fighting. They are trying to work with this group to try to help this group.
