COLLEGE CREDITS FOR GOOD GRADES!!!!

Dear Parents:

Did you know that Colorado Springs School District has an articulation agreement with Pikes Peak Community College for many of our courses?

Students who earn an A or B in the courses listed in the articulations list are eligible to receive articulated college credit from PPCC. Each articulated college course (3 PPCC college credits) is available for only \$10 ordinarily, but D11 will cover the cost when you register for the credit.

To apply for the credit you will need to go to the Pikes Peak Community College registrar's office. You will need to create a PPCC account. You will be walked through steps to complete general contact information including student's social security number, driver's license information and motor vehicle registration, military and personal information, high school information, future academic intent and residency questions. At the end of this process you will be given an "S#" that you will need to transfer to the teacher verification form we are sending home.

You may turn in your completed paperwork to your instructor of the Career and Technical Education Office.

If a student brings back a college transcript to the high school registrar they will then change their grade to a weighted grade on their high school transcript. Also you have 90 days from your graduation date to have any changes made to your high school transcript.

A demonstration of a completed transcribed articulated credit will also satisfy Postsecondary Workforce Readiness (PWR) graduation requirements for the class of 2021 and beyond.
