



How to Clear Your Browsing Data on your Chromebook


You **should clear** the **cache** on your **Google Chrome** browser periodically to ensure that it's functioning efficiently, as an overloaded **cache could** be slowing down your browsing experience.

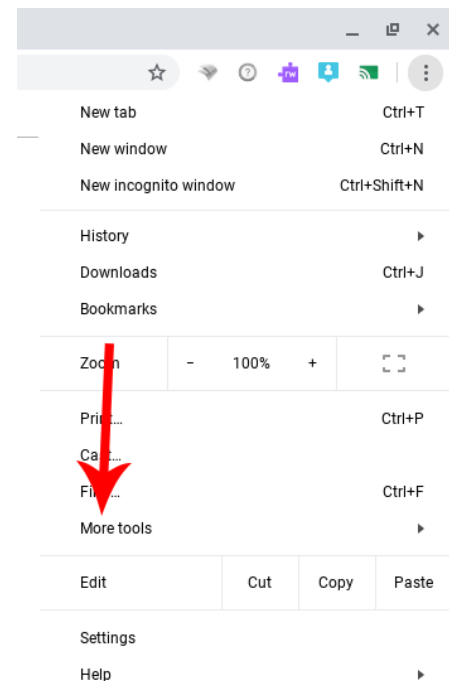
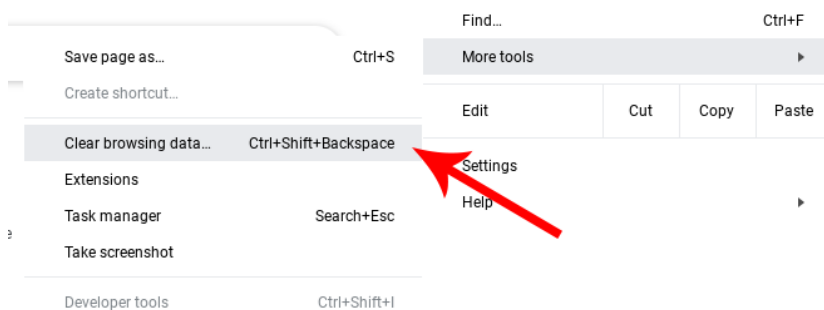
Clearing Your Browsing Data—Summary

1. On your Chromebook, open Chrome.
2. At the top right, click More .
3. Click More tools  Clear browsing data.
4. Choose a time range, like Last hour or All time.
5. Select the types of information you want to remove. Next to '**Browsing History**', '**Cookies and other site data**' and '**Cached images and files**', tick the boxes.
6. Click Clear data.

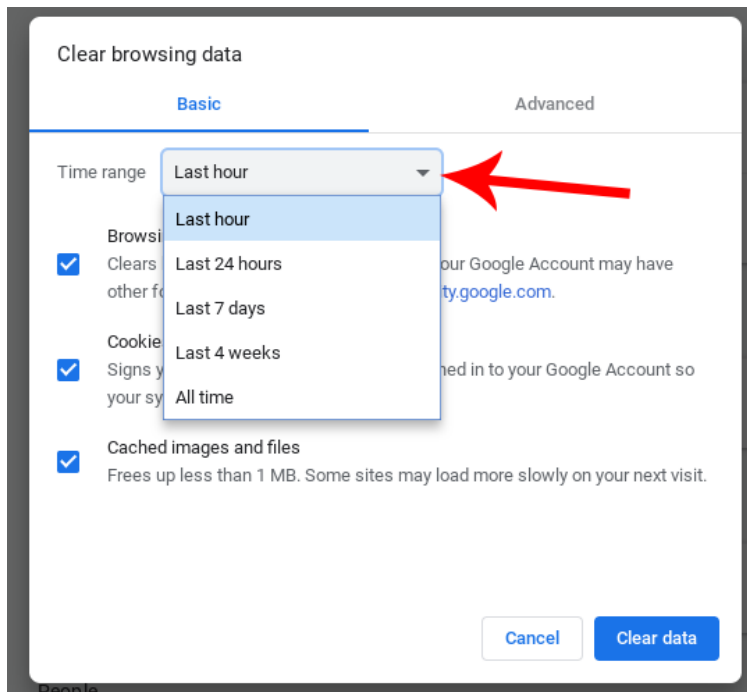
Clearing Your Browsing Data—Screenshots

On your Chromebook, open Chrome.

2. At the top-right, click More .
3. Click **More tools** > **Clear browsing data**.



4. At the top, select **All time**.



5. Next to 'Cookies and other site data' and 'Cached images and files', tick the boxes.

6. Click **Clear data**.
