- To-go breakfast will be offered at The Sanctuary Church at 9am on Sundays. They will also continue their pantry operations on the 1st and 3rd Saturdays of each month from 1-3pm.
- On Wednesdays and Sundays, Church of the Lord of Glory (500 W. Bijou St.) is offering a grab-and-go meal at 3pm.

- Suspended pantry sites due to Covid 19 include Sacred Heart (Monday, Thursday afternoons), Westside Community Center Thursday Night Pantry, and Manitou Congregational Church (Friday afternoons).

Westside Pantries, SNAP support, Grab and Go Meals

- Food pantry Tuesdays 1-3pm at Trinity United Methodist (710 N. 20th St.) will offer commodities only. No choice items will be offered, but commodities can be picked up.
- Food pantry Wednesdays 1-3pm at Westside Community Center, vouchers will be issued onsite and fewer “choice” items. You will not need to check in at Westside CARES before going to this pantry. Additionally, the Pet Pantry will be present on the fourth Wednesday of each month to provide pet food.
- The B Street Pantry Wednesdays from 1-3pm. Fewer choice options will be available.
